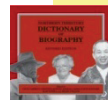
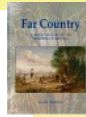
CDU Press is the publisher based at Charles Darwin University in Darwin, Northern Territory, Australia.

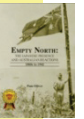
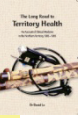
