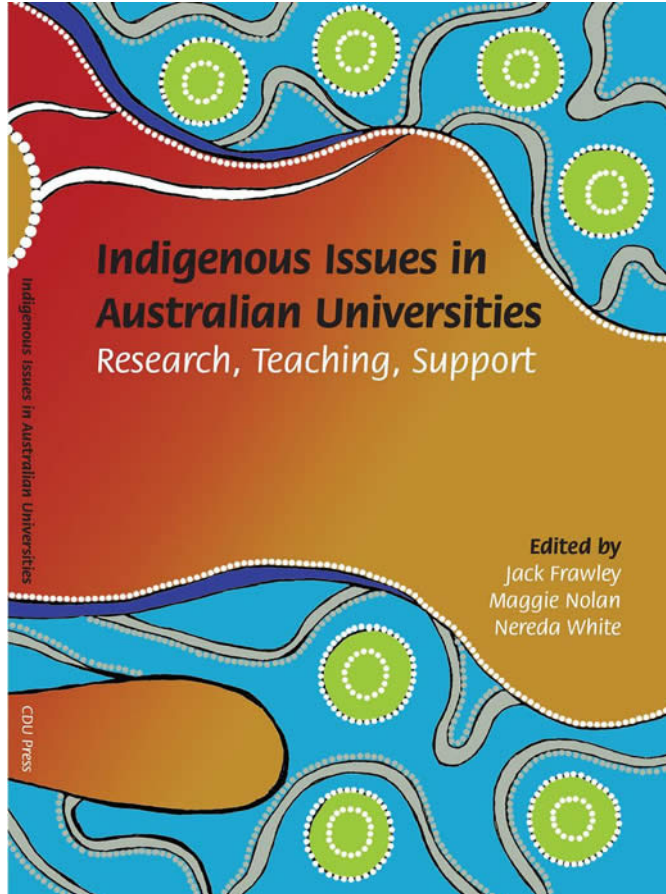


Charles Darwin University Press presents...
